BYRON BAY CARNIVAL RULES and TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- **1. Match points are accrued as:-** 4 points per win, 2 points per loss, 3 points per draw, 0 points per forfeit.
- 2. Your team is required to supply 1 person for bench (this will be 1 from each team just played) after every game played. It is your teams' responsibility & if you do not supply bench duty when required you will have points deducted from your accrued match point tally. If your team so desires, they may organize, through the court supervisor, a substitute bench official for a small fee. This should be arranged prior to your scheduled game.
- **3. All teams are required to provide a Badged referee,** to be available for rostered games. This Referee will be paid by the Carnival Referee Co-Ordinator.
- 4. 18 min halves, Running Clock for regular games (clock does not stop)
- 5. 1 time-out per half, clock does NOT stop
- 6. NO Time-outs in last 3 mins of regular games
- 7. All FINALS, fully timed for last 3 mins and the Clock WILL Stop for All Time-Outs.
- **8. Clock is to run on Time** (Court Supervisor and Head Referee have final say on game Start & Finish times, (NO EXCEPTIONS).
- **9.** If your team is late, 2 points will be awarded to the opposition team for every minute late. If you can't field your team by end of 1st half your team will forfeit the game. Minimum of 4 players required to start the game.
- **10. All players MUST be registered and eligible to play** (no exceptions), with their respective authorised State or Territory Basketball Association for insurance purposes; Byron Bay Basketball Association takes no responsibility for unregistered persons playing in the carnival.
- **11. All players' names MUST** be on the score sheet prior to the scheduled game start time with team captain indicated. NO players' names may be added after commencement of the game.
- 12. Players nominated CAN PLAY IN ONE TEAM ONLY & must Play 2 Games to be eligible to play in the finals.
- **13. GRAND FINAL GAMES resulting in a draw** will have extra time of 5mins. This will be repeated until a winner is declared.
- **14. Consumption of Alcohol whilst playing is NOT permitted**. Intoxicated players will not be permitted to participate in the game. This is up to the discretion of the referee and court supervisor. The court supervisor has absolute authority.
- **15. There is a zero tolerance policy towards violence.** Any player, spectator or official found to be abusive, fighting or striking any person at the stadium or function organized under the auspice of the basketball carnival will be banned from the stadium for the remainder of the event and will be referred to NSW police if deemed necessary.
- **16. Respect and goodwill should be displayed** to all players, officials and spectators at the carnival at all times.
- **17. Any issues with games or players** should be referred to the HEAD referee & Court Controller of the carnival.
- **18. Players are required to be 16 years of age** and older to participate. Individual requests for exemption will be considered and the decision of the Court Controller will be final.
- 19. Any participating team will not be permitted to play until their team nomination fee is FULLY PAID.
- 20. The Byron Bay Basketball Association Inc. holds the right to change any prize money payments, due to circumstances beyond their control. Such circumstances could be, but not limited to, a change to the draw due to withdrawal of teams without prior notification.
- 21. Team Divisions may be restructured due to Team Nomination numbers, without notice.
- 22. Due to COVID 19 we will adhere to any social distancing regulations required at the time of the carnival.
